The editors of the interdisciplinary *Australasian Journal of Irish Studies* and the Irish Studies Association of Australia and New Zealand are delighted to announce the 2023 ISAANZ Irish Studies Postgraduate Essay prize.

The Prize:

1. Publication of the winning essay in the *Australasian Journal of Irish Studies*, subject to normal academic refereeing
2. A cash prize of AUD\$300
3. A year's membership of Irish Studies Association of Australia and New Zealand.

Rules:

- Entry is open to anyone enrolled in an MA or PhD programme between June 2022 and June 2023 at any institution.
- Essays on any aspect of Irish Studies will be considered.
- Entries must be accompanied by the Entry Form.
- To be considered, essays **must** comply with the *Australasian Journal of Irish Studies* style guide: <https://isaanz.org/irish-studies-association-of-australia-and-new-zealand/ajis/contributor-guidelines/>
- Length 5000-8000 words.
- Essays entered for the Prize may be considered for publication in *AJIS* through the usual referring processes. Therefore NO essay entered for the prize should be submitted for publication elsewhere until judging is complete and entrants have been notified that *AJIS* will not be proceeding with referring.
